



# SPANISH TABLE

Expressions with *Estar*



**To indicate temporary state, position or situation.**

estar de + noun	estar de fiesta	to party	<i>Mis amigos y yo estamos de fiesta esta noche.</i>	My friends and I are partying tonight.
	estar de baja	to be on leave	<i>Ana está de baja. No se siente bien.</i>	Ana is on sick leave. She's not feeling well.
	estar de pie	to be standing	<i>Los estudiantes están de pie para su presentación.</i>	The students are standing for their presentation.
estar en + noun	estar en calma	to be calm	<i>El viento está en calma.</i>	The wind is calm.
	estar en pañales	to be in diapers/infancy	<i>La compañía está en pañales. Solo tiene un año.</i>	The company is in its infancy. It's only one year old.
estar con + noun	estar con gripe	to have the flu	<i>No me siento bien. Creo que estoy con gripe.</i>	I'm not feeling well. I think I have the flu.
	estar con dolor	to be in pain	<i>Mi niño está con dolor de estómago.</i>	My son has a stomachache.



# SPANISH TABLE

Expressions with *Estar*



## To indicate an upcoming event.

<i>estar a punto de</i> + infinitive	to be about to	<i>Estoy a punto de salir para tu casa.</i>	I'm about to leave to your place.
--------------------------------------	----------------	---	-----------------------------------

## To make assessments.

<i>estar para</i> + infinitive	to be ready/prepared to do something	<i>¡Qué barata está la ropa! Está para comprarla.</i>	These clothes are so cheap! We should buy them.
--------------------------------	--------------------------------------	---	--

## To indicate that someone is too old to do something, or that someone is not in the mood to do something.

<i>estar para</i> + noun	to be in the mood for	<i>No estamos para películas de terror.</i>	We're not in the mood for terror movies.
<i>estar para</i> + infinitive	to be too X to do something	<i>Yo no estoy para salir de noche. Si lo hago, me resfrío.</i>	I'm too old to go out at night. If I do, I get a cold.



# SPANISH TABLE

Expressions with *Estar*



## To indicate that an action hasn't been done or an intention.

<i>estar por</i> + infinitive	to be about to do something	<i>Estoy por limpiar la casa.</i>	The house is yet to be cleaned.
		<i>Estoy por planear mis vacaciones.</i>	I feel like planning my vacations.

## To indicate agreement.

<i>estar por</i> + noun	to be in favor of	<i>Nosotros estamos por la propuesta de Camila.</i>	We're in favor of Camila's proposal.
<i>estar por</i> + infinitive	to be in favor of	<i>Los trabajadores están por hacer huelga.</i>	The workers are in favor of going on strike.
