



How to use verb-resultative complement compounds in Mandarin Chinese?

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Let's recap! Common resultative complements are:

Resultative Complement	Examples of verb-resultative complement compound
见 jiàn to see	verb + 见 (jiàn)
到 dào to get / arrive	verb + 到 (dào)
住 zhù to reside	verb + 住 (zhù)
숲 huì able	verb + 会 (huì)
开 kāi opened	verb + 开 (kāi)
懂 d ŏng understood	verb + 懂 (dŏng)

Resultative Complement	Examples of verb-resultative complement compound
完 wán finished	verb + 完 (wán)
破 pò broken	verb+破(pò)
好 h ǎo good / done	verb + 好 (hǎo)
错 cuò wrong	verb + 错 (cuò)
干净 gānjìng clean	verb + 干净 (gānjìng)
清楚 qīngchu clear	verb + 清楚 (qīngchu)
