



# FRENCH TABLE

How to choose between *imparfait* and *passé composé*



Seven verbs that have a different meaning in the *imparfait* and in the *passé composé*.

Infinitive	Imparfait		Passé composé	
	Meaning	Example	Meaning	Example
avoir to have	had	<i>Il y a deux ans, j'<b>avais</b> un pull rayé.</i> Two years ago, I had a striped pullover.	received	<i>Pour mon anniversaire, j'<b>ai eu</b> un pull rayé.</i> For my birthday, I got a striped pullover.
connaître to know	knew	<i>Il <b>connaissait</b> bien cet acteur.</i> He knew this actor well.	met	<i>Il <b>a connu</b> cet acteur sur le tournage du film.</i> He met this actor on the film set.
devoir to have to	was/were supposed to	<i>Tu ne <b>devais</b> pas passer l'aspirateur ?</i> Weren't you supposed to vacuum?	had to	<i>Tu <b>as dû</b> passer l'aspirateur hier ?</i> Did you have to vacuum yesterday?
être to be	was/were	<i>Vous <b>étiez</b> fatigués ?</i> Were you tired?	got/became	<i>Vous <b>avez été</b> fatigués ?</i> Did you get tired?
pouvoir to be able to	was/were able to	<i>Je ne <b>pouvais</b> pas porter ma valise !</i> I couldn't carry my suitcase!	managed to	<i>Je n'<b>ai pas pu</b> porter ma valise !</i> I didn't manage to carry my suitcase!
savoir to know	knew	<i>Nous <b>savions</b> que tu avais des ennuis !</i> We knew you were in trouble.	found out	<i>Nous <b>avons su</b> que tu avais des ennuis.</i> We heard you were in trouble.
vouloir to want	wanted	<i>Elles <b>voulaient</b> une glace.</i> They wanted an ice cream.	decided to	<i>Elles <b>ont voulu</b> voyager.</i> They decided to travel.

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
