> 花儿在桌子上。 Huār zài zhuōzi shàng. Flowers are on the table.

椅子在桌子下。 Yǐzi zài zhuōzi xià. The chairs are under the table.

花儿在花盆中。 Huār zài huāpén zhōng. Flowers are in pots. 2 Sam上午从九点起开始上课。 Sam shàngwǔ cóng jiǔdiǎn qǐ kāishǐ shàngkè. Sam's class starts at nine in the morning.

> Sam从九点到十点上中文课。 Sam cóng jiǔdiǎn dào shídiǎn shàng Zhōngwén kè. Sam has Chinese class from nine to ten.

Sam从十点到十一点上数学课。 Sam cóng shídiǎn dào shíyīdiǎn shàng shùxué kè. Sam has math class from ten to eleven.

Sam从十一点到十二点上音乐课。 Sam cóng shíyīdiǎn dào shí'èrdiǎn shàng Yīnyuè kè. Sam has music lessons from eleven to twelve.

Sam下午从一点起开始上课。 Sam xiàwǔ cóng yīdiǎn qǐ kāishǐ shàngkè. Sam has lessons from one o'clock in the afternoon.

Sam从一点到两点上英语课。 Sam cóng yīdiǎn dào liǎngdiǎn shàng Yīngyǔ kè. Sam has English lessons from one to two.

Sam从两点到三点上体育课。 Sam cóng liǎngdiǎn dào sāndiǎn shàng tǐyù kè. Sam has a physical education class from two to three o'clock.

我的老板对我们很不好。 Wǒ de lǎobǎn duì wǒmen hěn bù hǎo. My boss treats us badly.

他对/对于不能帮助她感到难过。 Tā duì/duìyú bùnéng bāngzhù tā gǎndào nánguò. He is sad about not being able to help her.
