

## **ITALIAN TABLE**

Summary of Tense Sequencing with the Subjunctive



When in the main clause you have the PRESENT indicative

→ use the present subjunctive to express an action happening at the same time.

**25** 

Credo che Maria **arrivi** presto. (now) (now)

I think that Maria will arrive soon.

When in the main clause you have a PAST indicative tense (imperfetto, passato prossimo, etc.)

→ use the **imperfect subjunctive** to express an action that happened at the same time, but in the past!

Credo che Maria **arrivasse** subito.

(past) (past)

I thought that Maria would arrive soon.

→ use the **past subjunctive** to express an action that happened **before** the one expressed in the main clause:

**25** 

Credo che Maria sia già arrivata.

(now) (before)

I think that Maria has arrived already.

**24** 

→ use the **past perfect subjunctive** to express an action that happened **before** the one expressed in the main clause:

Temevo che **fossero già andati** via. (past) (before) I feared they had already left. 23
