



# FRENCH TABLE

Ordering Object Pronouns



10 common semi-auxiliaries which are followed by an infinitive verb.

Remember this order: subject + conjugated semi-auxiliary + object pronoun + infinitive verb.

Verbs	Translation	Example	Translation
<b>aimer</b>	to like, to love	<b><i>J'aime les écouter quand je suis triste.</i></b>	I like to listen to them when I'm sad.
<b>aller</b>	to go	<b><i>Je vais nous faire une omelette.</i></b>	I'm going to make an omelette for us.
<b>détester</b>	to hate	<b><i>Je déteste lui parler d'argent.</i></b>	I hate talking about money with him.
<b>devoir</b>	to have to, must	<b><i>Tu dois le porter quand il pleut !</i></b>	You must wear it when it's raining!
<b>essayer (de)</b>	to try to	<b><i>Tu essaies de lui téléphoner ?</i></b>	Are you trying to call her?
<b>pouvoir</b>	to be able to, can	<b><i>Il peut nous prêter sa voiture pour le week-end !</i></b>	He can lend us his car for the weekend.
<b>préférer</b>	to prefer	<b><i>Vous préférez me payer la semaine prochaine ?</i></b>	Do you prefer to pay me next week?
<b>refuser de</b>	to refuse to	<b><i>Nous refusons de te laisser sortir ce soir !</i></b>	We refuse to let you go out tonight!
<b>souhaiter</b>	to wish, to want	<b><i>Je souhaite vous remercier pour votre coopération.</i></b>	I want to thank you for your cooperation.
<b>venir (de)</b>	to come, to have just done	<b><i>Nous venons vous apporter un cadeau.</i></b>	We are coming to bring you a present.
<b>vouloir</b>	to want	<b><i>Je voudrais te dire un secret.</i></b>	I would like to tell you a secret.

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
